Day 1 – July 19, 2021

Lightning talks #1: Laying the Foundation for Inclusive Digital Development: Identifying inclusive digital development, the barriers, and the significance for development.

Discussion groups #1: Facilitated small groups to gather input on key concepts presented during the lightning talks.

Plenary report out and discussion #1: Facilitators summarize input from each discussion group and lead a general discussion.

Facilitated roundtable discussion #1: Broadening Perspectives: How differences in conceptions of fairness, inclusion, and equity across cultures, geographies, and political systems shape digital ecosystems and the innovation that occurs within them.

Discussion groups #2: Facilitated small groups to gather input on the concepts about differences across cultures, geographies, and political systems covered by the roundtable panel.

Plenary report out and discussion #2: Facilitators summarize input from each discussion group and lead a general discussion.

Day 2 – July 20, 2021

Lightning talks #2: Diagnosing Harms: Explore how the use, experience, and consequences of digital technologies varies across different groups and sectors, and brainstorm solutions for maximizing benefits and minimizing harms.

Discussion groups #3: Facilitated small groups to gather input on the diagnosing harm concept presented during the lightning talks.

Plenary report out and discussion #3: Facilitators summarize input from each discussion group and lead a general discussion.

Facilitated roundtable discussion #2: Identifying Levers of Change: Consider how stakeholders in digital ecosystems—communities, civil society, researchers, private sector, and government—produce and use evidence for inclusive innovation. This can include norm-building, local capacity development, policy interventions, and implementation practices to increase inclusivity, transparency, and accountability vis-à-vis digital technologies.

Discussion groups #4: Facilitated small groups to gather input on stakeholder concepts covered by the roundtable panel.

Plenary report out and discussion #4: Facilitators summarize input from each discussion group and lead a general discussion.

Day 3 – July 21, 2021

Discussion groups #5: Facilitated small groups to gather input and discuss priorities for the knowledge gaps and potential research questions identified in Days 1 and 2 sessions and added to the shared online document.

Plenary discussion #5: Facilitators summarize input from each discussion group and lead a general discussion to identify the knowledge gaps and research questions to contribute to the workshop report.

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
